**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED:**

The Administrator shall make a second distribution of settlement checks, consistent with the approved Allocation Plan, to class members who had made a timely claim and cashed their settlement check;

The Administrator shall not reissue checks from the first distribution for any request received on or after August 22, 2017, until such time as the checks from the second distribution become stale; and

After the second distribution of checks becomes stale, so long as there are sufficient funds in the Settlement Fund due to uncashed checks from the second distribution, the Administrator shall reissue checks to class members who so request and, if there are insufficient funds, shall make reissuances *pro rata*.
